Boundary Amendments



A member (a local government or rural district) of an RSC wants to become a member of another RSC.

LGC

The member would make a request to the LGC.

MINISTER

LGC recommends to the Minister of Local Government that the RSC boundary be amended.

The description of a region may only be amended where:



The boundaries of the local government(s) or rural district(s) becoming a member or a group of members of another RSC are contiguous to the boundary of the RSC receiving the member(s).



Proponents (a Local government or rural district) have prepared and provided an impact study to the LGC for review.



Once the impact study review is complete, the LGC will determine and report to the Minister whether, in its opinion, sufficient local support for the amendment to the description of the region in question has been demonstrated.
